Changing Lives, One Adoption At A Time



- 141 cat adoptions and 60 dog adoptions!
- Tiff DeBrower and Leslie Becker joined Safe Haven staff as new dog direct care providers.
- \$13,500 in Grants received:
 - o Iowa County Community Foundation, \$5500, used for kennels
 - Miccio Foundation Grant, \$1500 in the spring, used for new kennels
 - Miccio Foundation Grant, \$4000, will be used for air conditioning and drainage in the pound and community rooms
 - o Amana Community Chest, \$500, used for large outdoor donation storage containers
 - o South Slope (Aureon) \$500, used for cat isolation unit
 - o Animal Relief Foundation (ARF) \$2,000, used for heartworm tests
 - LoveContribution MuttNation, \$1,000, and Johnson County Community Foundation/Don Merryman, \$1,000, which have not been used yet.
- Our survivors who required extra TLC: Mikey, who required both eyes to be removed;
 Bartholomeow and Mr. Fuzzy, who required amputations; Dora, who needed some inventive treatment for "Happy Tail"; and heartworm treatment for Baloo and Sky.
- 65 cat spays, 73 cat neuters, 13 dog spays, and 15 dog neuters.
- \$26,515 was raised in the Spring & Fall Plant Sales.
- \$8,531 was raised at the November 5K and Pancake breakfast.
- \$7,313 was raised at the Fall bake sale.
- Can & Bottle recycling raised \$6,871.00 which helped get feral and community cats spayed and neutered for the TNR program.
- 95 Hawkeye athletes spent a total of 493 hours volunteering at Safe Haven.
- 97 new volunteer orientations were given and 44 new direct care volunteers joined us.
- Safe Haven pups made 20 visits to area care facilities.
- Safe Haven pups visited KHAK radio station for 12 Furry Fridays with Brain and Courtlin.
- Safe Haven long term resident Stewie, a beautiful pitbull with big brown eyes, was adopted after 729 days.
- Amanda Wiebold and Elly Hoehnle were elected to the 2025 board and Amy Reihman & Andrea
 Prymek ended their four years of service on the board. Many thanks for all that they have done for
 Safe Haven!




